The first edition of CiDReS will held in Granada and will be co-located with the Conference of the Spanish Association for Artificial Intelligence (CAEPIA).

- 1. Original works written in English or Spanish. They may consist of up to **six (6) pages** (references included) following the IEEE style templates (<u>Word</u> y <u>LaTeX</u>).
- 2. Papers related to at least one of the topics of the workshop and recently accepted (key works) in journals with impact factor. They may consist of up to **two (2) pages** following the IEEE style templates (<u>Word</u> y <u>LaTeX</u>). The authors must also submit a cover letter indicating the journal in which the paper is published, and a succinct justification of the relation of the paper with the topics of the workshop.

Submission is electronic, using the <u>EasyChair</u> conference management system.
