Paper Submission Guidelines

- Papers must be written in English, in the Springer LNCS format, and must not exceed 4 pages, including all tables, figures and refernces (https://www.springer.com/gp/computer-science/lncs/conference-proceedings-guidelines)
 Submissions over four pages will be rejected without review.
- Papers must be submitted through EquinOCS at https://equinocs.springernature.com/service/IBERAMIA2024

All submissions will go through a double blind peer review evaluating originality, relevance, significance, technical soundness, quality and clarity. Thus, author names and affiliations must be omitted from the submission. Self-references should be avoided. All papers must be original and not simultaneously submitted to other venue.

Conference Registration and Attendance

At least one late breaking paper author is required to register in the conference, up to September 30th, and should be available to present the paper.

Publication

LBP will be published in the Proceedings by Springer in the «Advances in Artificial Intelligence», LNCS/LNAI series.
